

Tentative Course Schedule

Dates of concerts are as follows:

Evening concerts will all begin at 6:30 p.m. in the auditorium. Any changes will be sent home in writing. Students will need to be dressed for performances in concert black.

BOYS

White shirt
Black pants
Black socks and shoes

GIRLS

White blouse
Black pants or skirt
Black socks/stockings and shoes
Black dress may be worn in place of blouse and pants/skirts

Concerts are mandatory and are worth 250 points. This is used as a type of final exam for the semester. The **only exceptions** will be in the case of illness (requiring a doctor visit or the good judgment of a parent), or a family emergency (funerals or other events beyond your scheduling control). A concert can be "made up" with a note stating the reason for the missed concert, and a 2-page paper on a topic decided upon by the student and the teacher. The student will have until the end of the quarter to hand in the paper. Failure to do so will result in half credit (125 points). Athletic events, family outings, practices, concert tickets, etc., are not included as exceptions. Any other absences will automatically result in a 0 out of 250 points. Extra credit assignments may be done for up to 125 points. Extra credit can include:

* Attend a Concert -- Attend a "classical" style music concert. This could be a concert band, orchestra, choir, jazz band, or a musical, not a "pop style" concert. Return a program from the concert, as well as a one-page critique of the performance.

* Research paper -- This is a 2-page (at least) research paper on a period of history, a musician, or a composer. The student and teacher will discuss the topic before the paper is written.

* Other extra credit as decided upon by the teacher, student, and parent/guardian.
